# Admission Requirements

Students are expected (but not required) to have a minimum of TOEFL iBT 79, IELTS 6.0, Duolingo 105 (or equivalent) to be functional in a classroom setting. Proof of English proficiency will be requested at the time of application. Programs are geared towards undergraduate students, although graduate students and working professionals are welcome.
