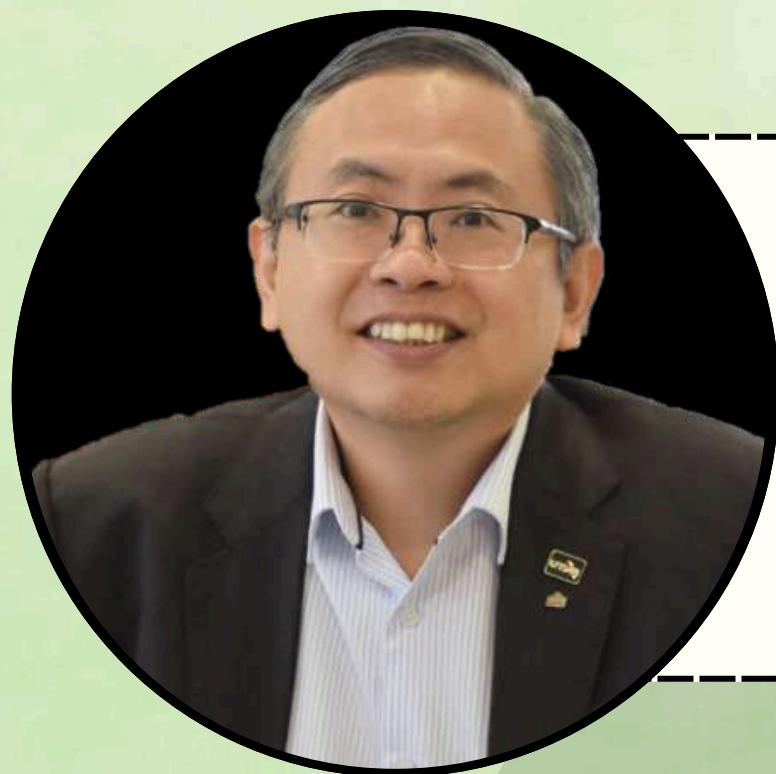
Universities could also play a vital role in creating ESG awareness and enhancing the experience of staff and students in terms of sustainability and social responsibility.
